For some subjects there will be revisiting of core ideas from the work that was set during the period of remote learning in others the focus will be on consolidating key skills that they will need to be able to successfully use as they approach their final exams.

Teachers will be uploading resources, setting home learning and their end of programme assessments via their google classrooms, which students have already been invited to join. Students can communicate directly with their class teachers via the google classroom if they have a question or would like additional help.
